The International Society for Applied Ethology

The Society was created in Edinburgh in 1966, as the Society for Veterinary Ethology. It rapidly expanded to cover all applied aspects of Ethology and other Behavioural Sciences that are relevant to human-animal interactions, such as farming, wildlife management, the keeping of companion and laboratory animals, and the control of pests. The Society also became increasingly international: it now has a federal, international structure as well as regional representatives around the world. In 1991 the society was re-named the International Society for Applied Ethology (ISAE).

Administration is the responsibility of a Council, which additionally provides technical evidence on topics relating to animal behaviour and animal welfare during the committee stages of government legislation, for example, by discussion with groups such as the UK's Farm Animal Welfare Council. Council is also consulted on such matters by the European Parliament and the Council of Europe.

ISAE Objectives

1. To encourage and support basic and applied research into the behaviour of animals used by humans, including domestic, laboratory, zoo, companion, pest and captive animals or managed wild animals.
2. To provide an international forum for scientists to communicate and discuss the results of this research.
3. To encourage links between applied animal behaviour science and other disciplines.
4. To encourage and support the teaching of ethology, especially in departments of veterinary and animal sciences, and those concerned with laboratory animals, companion animals or captive wildlife.
5. To provide a pool of expertise to national governments, international bodies, industry and animal welfare organizations that deal with problems involving animal behaviour. To encourage the assimilation of scientific knowledge and facilitate its use to improve the way animals are kept and cared for.

The Society assembles for one major International Congress each year, where members present the latest research findings. Regional meetings are also held on a regular basis. Members automatically receive the biannual ISAE newsletter and memos posted on the ISAE net-L electronic forum, as well as privileged access to the official ISAE website.
