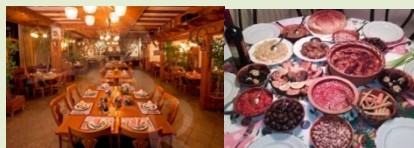

## CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

### Please carefully follow the instructions below:

- Abstracts should be submitted in ENGLISH only.
- The title must be underlined, typed in capital letters.
- The author's SURNAME must be in capital letters, followed by first name.
- The name of the speaker-author must be followed by an asterisk (\*).
- Include department, institute, city and country, but not street names, etc...
- The abstracts must be laid out in terms of: **Introduction - Materials and Methods – Results - Conclusions.**
- Use "Times New Roman" typeface points 11.
- Maximum length of the abstracts should be 450 words and with no more than 5 key words.
- The reception of the abstracts will be confirmed by email.

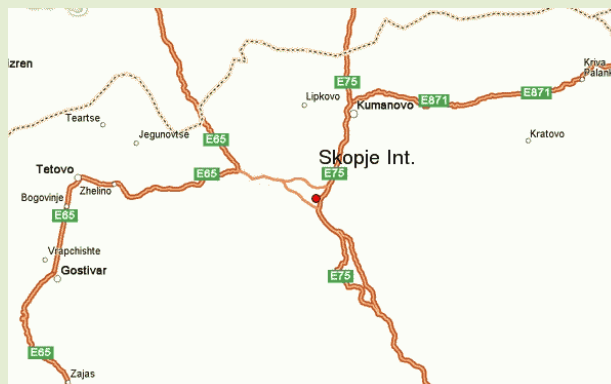
