## 9th IZSAM “G. Caporale” Special Prize

Awarded within the framework of the

## 23rd “Gianni di Venanzo” Cinematographic Photography International Award

Within the context of the 23<sup>rd</sup> Cinematographic Photography International Award “Gianni Di Venanzo”, the Istituto Zooprofilattico Sperimentale dell’Abruzzo e del Molise “G. Caporale” (IZSAM), in collaboration with the Teramo Nostra Cultural Association, holds the 9<sup>th</sup> edition of the **IZSAM “G. Caporale” Special Prize on “Human-animal relationship”**. Film-makers and documentarians are invited to submit their works, newly developed or already existing but considered suitable for this competition.

### Regulation

#### Article 1

The **IZSAM “G. Caporale” Special Prize** aims to raise public awareness on animal welfare and to promote a positive human-animal relationship. The Prize intends to award the best photography among documentaries or short films and to promote them over specialized festivals and/or competitions.

#### Article 2

The **IZSAM “G. Caporale” Special Prize** is organized in collaboration between the Istituto Zooprofilattico Sperimentale dell’Abruzzo e Molise “G. Caporale” and the Cultural Association Teramo Nostra.

#### Article 3

The **IZSAM “G. Caporale” Special Prize** can be only awarded to unreleased documentaries or short films or to works that have never been awarded in similar competitions.

#### Article 4

The proposed video can be a documentary or a short film; there are no restrictions about their audiovisual “artistic” form, but they must concern the **“Human-animal relationship”** topic.

#### **Article 5**

This Award is open to film-makers and documentarians, all over the world. The video can be coauthored. There is no age limit. Each participant can compete with one work, even though competing on his own or in a group. People under 18 years of age must have their parent or guardian consensus.

#### **Article 7**

The video and the application form are to be sent to the **Istituto Zooprofilattico Sperimentale dell’Abruzzo e del Molise “G. Caporale”, Reparto Comunicazione Istituzionale , Via Campo Boario, 64100 Teramo – Italy** by October the 8th, 2018 at the latest (the postmark serving as proof) in a sealed envelope that must bear the words **IZSAM “G. Caporale” Special Prize**. The works will not be returned. The organization will be not responsible for any postal deliveries hiccups.

#### **Article 8**

The **IZSAM “G. Caporale” Special Prize** jury is composed by the IZSAM General Director (or his delegate) and by directors of Cinematographic Photography. The jury will choose the best documentary or short film according to these general terms and conditions; its decision is final. In establishing the winner, equal winners are not expected. The jury reserves the right to not award the Prize if the standards of the proposed videos were to be considered poor.

#### **Article 9**

The 1st Prize consist in 700,00 € as a partial reimbursement of costs.

#### **Article 10**

The proceedings of the jury shall be confidential. No request of clarification on the judge’s opinion will be accepted before the announcement of the prize-winner.

#### **Article 11**

The movie must be sent **in DVD format**, and it must have a **minimum of 5 minutes and a maximum of 15 minutes** of running time.

#### **Article 12**

The Award ceremony and the winning video show will be held in Teramo on October the 13<sup>th</sup> 2018, in the occasion of the 23rd Cinematographic Photography International Award “Gianni Di Venanzo”. The Organization may decide to anticipate or postpone the date.

#### **Article 13**

While committing itself to take good care of the videos, the Organization will not be responsible for any loss or damage, which may occur after their shipment.
