Call for abstracts

Presentations are invited dealing with any and all aspects of the behaviour and welfare of domestic and confined animals. Please read the following instructions prior to submitting your abstract:

1. Use a Microsoft Word-compatible word processing program, or submit a text only document.
2. Abstracts should consist of the title, names of authors and their institutional addresses (including e-mail), and the main body of the text. The main body should be no more than **300 words**. Abstracts must contain a clear statement of the purpose of the work, methods used (including the number of animals or experimental units), results obtained, and conclusions. Results should be presented in sufficient detail to support the conclusions drawn. Except for theoretical contributions and review papers, submitted abstracts must contain data, indicate the method(s) of analysis, and provide information about statistical significance. References, tables or figures should not be included.
3. For each abstract CLEARLY indicate whether it is submitted for a 5 minute oral presentation or a full 15 minute oral presentation.
4. Submit abstracts by e-mail to Amy Quinn (amy.quinn@teagasc.ie). The file should be named "YOUR SURNAME.doc" and the email subject heading must read "ISAE ABSTRACT". **The deadline for abstract submission is Monday the 2nd of December 2019.**

Oral Presentations:

1. Oral presentations will be allotted 15 minutes (10 min for presenting, 5 min discussion) or 5 minutes (4 min for presenting, 1 min discussion). Please indicate your preference upon submission of the abstract.
2. Presentations must be compatible with Microsoft PowerPoint.
